DC has one of the highest rates of child maltreatment in the country.

Child abuse is a heinous crime, a public health scourge, and an "Adverse Childhood Experience" (ACE), which, if unaddressed, can have severe and long-lasting consequences for both individuals and society.

At least 1 out of every 100 children in DC is reported as being abused. However, that statistic is low because child abuse is an underreported crime. For a host of reasons most child victims wait until they're adults to disclose – if they ever do. Indeed, it's estimated that only 12% of child victimization is reported around the actual time it occurs.

When not addressed in a timely and appropriate way, child abuse can lead to lasting physical and emotional damage in adulthood.





The good news: Children can heal <u>and</u> child abuse is preventable!

There are things we can do, as individuals, as a community, and as members of society, to strengthen families and keep kids safe and healthy.

With support, survivors of childhood abuse can grow up to live healthy, fulfilling lives.

Safe Shores is on-call 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, providing free, survivor-centered services to child victims.
